UPDATED PUBLIC SAFETY RESPONSE

As we continue to navigate in these unprecedented times, I want to reassure all residents your safety and concerns are our utmost priority. We will continue to provide the exceptional service you deserve and are accustomed to. In order to protect our first responders and the public, you may see a few temporary changes with our response to calls. As always, every call we take will be screened and assigned to an officer. If your call is non-emergent in nature and can be handled over the phone, we will do so to minimize person to person contact. In the event of any emergency there will be no change to how our officers respond to calls. If your call requires a Public Safety Officer to respond to your house, we will respond. However, our call takers or the Public Safety Officer may ask a few more questions related to people being sick in your house. You may also be asked to come out of your house to speak to the responding officers. All the precautions we are taking are for your safety and the safety of the first responders. Your safety is always our number one priority.

Anyone who comes to City Hall may utilize the call box next to the front door to reach a call taker who will screen your call and provide you with the appropriate resources or response.
